North Florida Safety Council PRINCIPLES OF SAFETY MANAGEMENT

Just as a company should be committed to loss control, so should employees. Earning a Principles of Safety Management (PSM) Certificate requires time and a commitment to learning. A total of 50 credits must be earned within three years to receive certification (40 credits of CORE Courses and 10 credits of electives). Once the certificate is earned, an additional 16 credits for a two year period is required to maintain certification. All graduates will receive an updated certificate yearly upon completion of required credits.

Complete 10 CORE Courses and 3 elective Courses for class completion. Annual credits are needed to keep certification active. You do not have to be enrolled in PSM to take these programs.
